Your membership in the Fish and Game allows you access to the outdoor range (rules below), indoor rifle and pistol range (rules below), archery events, pond, and property. Property hunting rights are reserved for members who attend one of the hunting permission meetings in June, July, and August. There will be times when the outdoor range will be closed - namely during rentals, meetings, and any special events on the grounds. A listing of these closures will be posted on the website whenever possible. There is a "Range Closed" sign that should be posted, but possibly will be overlooked. This does not mean that the outdoor range is open for shooting and it is your responsibility to check.

Outdoor Range Safety Rules

Only Fish and Game Club members or their guests are permitted to use the range. Any guest must be accompanied by a member and may not shoot without the member present.

- 1. The outdoor range can be used during daylight hours whenever the Club House is not rented. You may want to check the schedule of events and rentals on the website before coming to the range. (http://defiancefishandgame.com)
- 2. Any rifle or pistol can be used on paper targets. Shotguns are not to be used with target frames provided by the Club.
- 3. Shooters must use the target frames provided or bring their own. Alignment must be checked to ensure that your bullets will impact the earth backstop. Shooting at ground level targets or targets on top of the mound is prohibited. Bullets striking the ground or top of the backstop can result in ricochet bullets entering the woods behind the backstop.
- 4. All shooters must use the same firing line to insure no one is down range.
- 5. The maximum distance of this range is 100 yards. Do not shoot from a position behind the firing line shelter.
- 6. All guns must be unloaded, and actions opened when going down range to score or change targets.
- 7. When finished shooting, please dispose of your targets and pick up any shell cases and any trash that you notice.
- 8. As when shooting any firearm, eye and hearing protection is strongly encouraged.
- 9. Do not shoot any steel targets (or frames) with high power rifles.
- 10. Any person violating any of the rules will forfeit their membership.

Defiance Area Rifle and Pistol Club Indoor Range Rules

- 1. <u>All</u> firearms will remain unloaded until on the firing line and the Range Officer gives the command "load". If you are the only member present, you are the Range Officer.
- 2. <u>All</u> firearms must have the cylinders open (revolvers), or the slides locked open (pistols), or actions open (rifles), when the Range Officer gives the command cease fire or the buzzer sounds.
- 3. When leaving the firing line, put firearm in safe mode and with the muzzle (barrel) pointing straight down or in a case or box.
- 4. The red light will be turned on to signify the Range Officer has checked the range and all firearms on the line are empty with actions open. It is then safe to go down range to post or score targets. The red light will be turned off, when all people are behind the firing line
- 5. No magnum loads will be fired on the indoor range. Prohibited firearms are: 22 magnum, 17HMR, shotguns, and centerfire rifles.
- 6. Permitted firearms are: 22 caliber rifles, handguns with lead or jacketed bullets and non-magnum loads.
- 7. An Adult must accompany all junior shooters!
- 8. All shooters and spectators in the shooting area are required to wear ear and eye protection.
- 9. <u>Practice the 4 rules of gun safety</u>:
 - 1. All guns are assumed to be loaded until you establish, they are or not by opening the action and visually inspecting the firearm. If you think it is unloaded, check it again. Remember to check the chamber as well as the magazine.
 - 2. Never let the muzzle cover anything you are not willing to destroy. Keep your gun pointed in a safe direction at all times: on the range, at home, loading, or unloading.
 - 3. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target and you are ready to shoot.
 - 4. Be sure of your target. Know what it is, what is in line with it and what is behind it. Never shoot at anything that you haven't positively identified.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages allowed.

Straightened Arrows

You are entitlement to use the outdoor archery range year-round and shoot all outdoor club leagues at no additional charge. Please check the calendar or the website for a listing of these shoots. Only field points may be used when shooting targets.

Lost Key Card

Lost key cards will be replaced at a cost of \$5. You will need to come to a club meeting to obtain the replacement card and at that time your original card will be deactivated. After being issued a replacement, should you find your original key card it will no longer work.
